A-B-C-Learn to do Old World Chip Carving with 3 easy cuts! This is for the beginner and the more experienced carver. The pattern is rubber cemented on there is no drawing. Just start carving! First, do a practice piece to learn the technique of Old-World chip carving. Beginning students then choose to carve a beautiful design on small box, a napkin holder, a trivet, a phone or tablet holder, or small project. The range is from \$12 - \$27 depending upon your choice. Returning students may choose any project that is in the book published by Jan if she has the supplies. She will provide wipe-on poly, a practice board, and patterns. Her books will be available for purchase – Blue Ribbon Chip Carving and More Blue-Ribbon Chip Carving as well as her third "book" called Even More Blue Ribbon Chip Carving. Students will need a good chip carving knife. Also bring light and magnifying glasses (if necessary). FRED & ELAINE STENMAN 11 A-B-C- 12 A-B-C-D- 13 A-B-C-D-E- LOW RELIEF CARVING (New students see info below)



Students will learn the techniques developed by Elaine and Fred, which combines low relief carving with details that are wood burned. The carvings are painted with thinned acrylics and stained with oil paint. Tool techniques for full sized gouges and wood burning tools along with elements of design will be taught. New students execute a small (6"x9") practice piece which is just wood burned and painted (no carving). This will be followed by the main project piece (approx. 9" wide x 15" or 12.5" rounded) which has the main design elements relief carved and wood burned details. Students may select from Stenman's original designs including an old barn or cabin with wildlife, or other details. The projects will be carved in basswood with the bark remaining on the edges to create a natural frame. The paints and brushes are provided as part of the class fee. The basswood boards vary in price and size. Students who are new to the class will be encouraged to do our red barn or cabin relief as they are a great learning experience. Other projects will be available for returning students. Returning students who want to carve a larger and/or more complex project, as well as students who would like to do more than one carving, should sign up for all five days to make it possible to finish. If you have a special project in mind, please contact us at least a week before the class begins.

Materials furnished:

The paints and brushes are provided as well as stop boards and lights.

Instructors will provide boards at additional cost. NOTE: THE COST OF THE BOARDS IS NOT INCLUDED IN THE PRICE OF THE SEMINAR.

12 1/2" rounded board: \$18.00- \$25.00

6" X 9" printed practice board (optional): \$8.00

Materials needed

Padded 22"-24" Stool (Especially for those with back problems).

#3/35 mm Swiss Made. The Flexcut #220799 1½" or a Stubai #4/35 may be substituted for this gouge. #3 sweep Swiss Made or #3 sweep Denny (or other) gouges in various sizes from 10mm to 20mm. A good wood burner, such as Colwood or Optima. We use Colwood "B" and "J" pens and Optima Ph11 Pens.

Some large #3/35mm gouges and some wood burners are available for student use.

WHIMSICAL BARK HOUSE: Learn the basics of designing and carving a fun and impressive whimsical bark house.

(TWO DAYS recommended for these project)

COTTAGE: Carved from 2 pieces of bark and joined together for a near seamless fit and, if time allows, a tree to enhance the cottage.

TREE HOUSE: Carve a whimsical treehouse out of 2 pieces of cottonwood bark, shaped around a piece of found wood for the trunk to create a unique presentation.

(THREE DAYS recommended for this project)

CHURCH: This project may be a bit challenging, even for experience carvers, but it will help take your skills to the next level. Students will begin with a piece of cottonwood bark cut out to basic shape of a church. They will learn new and different techniques to create customized details, using their own ideas or from pictures of churches that will be provided.

Supplies Needed:

Carving knife and safety glove, 3/32" & Large V-tool, needle file set (may be purchased from instructor for \$10.00), pin vise with small drill bits, 1/8" & 1/4" #1 chisels, 5/16" # 7 U-gouge.
